CRIME SCENE & FORENSIC PHOTOGRAPHY OF PHYSICAL EVIDENCE



COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course provides law enforcement crime scene investigators the skills needed to conduct forensic photography of physical evidence as well as conduct general crime scene photography. Topics include legal admissibility, photographic coverage, major crime scene photography, film speed, lighting techniques, and photographic equipment. Pass/No Pass only.

Upon completion of the course, all students will receive an ARC SRPSTC Certificate of Completion and a grade submitted for their college transcripts.

Important Note: Students are strongly encouraged to arrive on time in order to complete the registration process and avoid impeding instructional time. Late students who miss this process will not be allowed to attend the course.

REQUIREMENTS:

Students are required to bring their own cameras (preferably SLR cameras – digital or film), lenses (normal, macro, & zoom), owner's manuals, tripods, memory cards, electronic flash attachments, lens filters, and if possible any other crime scene photographic equipment and supplies issued by their department for use at crime scenes. It is also highly recommended that each student familiarize themselves with the operation and settings of their camera before the start of this course.
