TRAFFIC COLLISION INVESTIGATION - BASIC

COURSE DESCRIPTION:	This course provides in-depth instruction into the multiple disciplines of traffic collision investigation. Topics include scene management techniques and an introduction to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, highway engineering definitions, Nine-Cell Matrix, incident scene photography, primary collision factors, identification and documentation of physical evidence, measuring and diagramming methodology, use of a traffic template's nomographs and functions, and an in-depth discussion on proper traffic collision documentation per Highway Patrol Manual 110.5, Collision Investigation Manual (CIM). This course satisfies the prerequisites for the Intermediate Collision Investigation course, as well as the requirements of California Vehicle Code Section 40600.	
	Upon completion of the course, all students will receive an ARC SRPSTC Certificate of Completion and a grade submitted for their college transcripts. Only in-service peace officers shall receive POST credit.	
	<u>Important Note:</u> Students are strongly encouraged to arrive on time in order to complete the registration process and avoid impeding instructional time. Late students who miss this process will not be allowed to attend the course.	
PREREQUISITES:	Beginning 8/1/2024, POST-certified basic law enforcement academy or equivalent as determined by the Dean of Academy Instruction. NOTE: Approval of equivalent training is not a guarantee that state regulatory or licensing agencies will also grant equivalency.	
MATERIALS NEEDED:	Highlight marker and a calculator with square root function are recommended.
