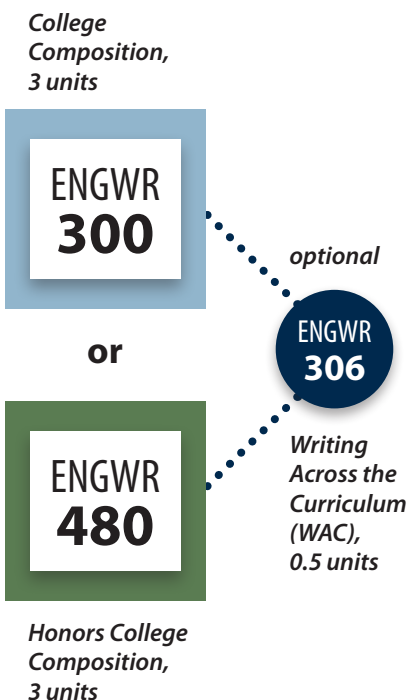


# ENGWR 300 or ENGWR 480

## PLACEMENT

Based on a review of your academic record, you are eligible for **ENGWR 300: College Composition** or **ENGWR 480: Honors College Composition**.

## THE COURSES

**ENGWR 300: College Composition** emphasizes the writing, reading, and critical thinking skills you'll use in the classes where writing is required. It also meets graduation and transfer requirements.

**ENGWR 480: Honors College Composition** satisfies the same requirements as ENGWR 300 but offers smaller class sizes and is part of the ARC Honors Program.

## ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

Students who take these courses often benefit from additional support in **ENGWR 306: Advanced Writing Across the Curriculum**, a 0.5 unit support course.

## ENGWR 300 AND 480

- Meet prerequisite requirements for ENGWR 301, 302, 303, 481 and 482
- Meet AA/AS graduation requirements (ARC GE A1)
- Transfer to four-year universities (CSU GE A2 and IGETC 1A)
- ENGWR 480 can be counted towards the ARC Honors Transfer Certificate
