Any student eligible for the regular course is also eligible for the Honors version.</p> <p>Students in ENGL C1000H can take part of the ARC Honors Transfer Certificate Program.</p>	<p><i>Succeeding in Academic Reading & Writing, 2 units</i></p> <div>ENGWR 94</div> <div>ENGL C1000</div> <p><i>Academic Reading & Writing, 3 units</i></p> <p>Students enroll in the transfer-level writing class ENGL C1000 and ENGWR 94, a class designed to help students succeed in ENGL C1000.</p> <p>Each section of ENGWR 94 has its own connected section of ENGL C1000, which students can find in the course notes of the schedule or in eServices.</p>
Second Semester	<div>ENGWR 301</div> or <div>ENGL C1001</div> or <div>ENGWR 303</div> <p>These courses meet AA/AS requirements and Cal-GETC Area 1B.</p> <p>ENGWR 303 or ENGWR 301 AND ENGL C1000 meet requirements for the English AA-T.</p> <p>Students can also register for ENGWR 481 or ENGL C1000H, which meet the same requirements and are part of the ARC Honors Transfer Certificate Program.</p>
