The American River College Child Development Center offers developmentally appropriate programs to assist children as they grow to their fullest potential. The family must meet eligibility criteria (income and need) as established by the California Department of Education, Early Education Division, in order to be eligible to receive subsidized care. Non-subsidized care slots are available; please ask office staff for details.

We recommend you enroll in classes that are timed back-to-back if possible. We also recommend that you have alternative child care plans until a spot is available as we are unable to guarantee enrollment. Once a spot for your child is available, we will contact you to schedule an enrollment appointment. It is important that you provide accurate contact information.

The ARC Child Development Center is not licensed for drop-in care. Child care schedules are set at enrollment based on the family's school and work schedule. Families must follow their contract schedule hours.
