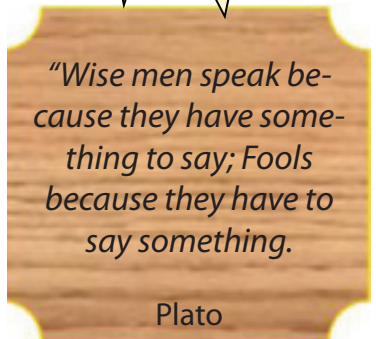
The Parrot: Yeah, but Daily Mirror? Sounds like a cosmetics magazine or the name of a Snow White movie. I'm prepared.
