





modeled after the garb of aerial circus performers and wrestlers of the era in which the first superheroes proudly donned their underpants over their tights.

Now, it should be noted here that the wrestlers, circus performers, and superheroes weren't actually wearing underwear, but rather tight underwear-like shorts over their leggings. As superheroes are generally incredibly gifted athletically and perform amazing acrobatic stunts while crime fighting, it was natural enough for this style of dress to get adopted by the earliest superhero artists for their characters.

Two of the earliest major representations of this can be found in Flash Gordon (1934), which in turn was partially the inspiration for the garb of Superman (1938), with the principle difference being the colors of their uniforms and the fact that Superman had a cape (as far as I can find, the first major superhero to wear one).

Of course, if you still want to think of the superhero tight-shorts as underwear, given that Superman and others often wear their uniform under their normal clothes, it kind of makes sense.

Bonus Fact: The original Superman character envisioned by Jerry Siegal and Joe Shuster was not the crime-fighting hero from another world we know today. Instead, they made him a bald bad guy set on ruling the world in the 1933 The Reign of Superman. In this story, a character by the name of Bill Dunn is waiting in a soup kitchen line when Professor Ernest Smalley offers him food and new clothes in exchange for his participation in an experiment.

The Professor proceeds to give him a potion that makes Dunn telepathic; he then becomes a super-man, and tries to take over the world. However, in the process, he kills Professor Smalley, only to discover later that his powers are temporary unless he has more potion to drink, which he can't figure out how to recreate. Ultimately, the former Superman finds himself without his powers and back in the soup kitchen line.

A year after writing that story, Siegel re-cast the character of Superman, this time making him a hero bent on righting the wrongs prominent in society at the time. They also decided to switch Superman's name from "Bill Dunn" to "Clark Kent," after famed actors Kent Taylor and Clark Gable.



For example, if you want to say that you are not a villain, you can make a sentence that says, "I'm no villain." This sentence lets everyone know, very clearly, that you are not a villain. Notice that this sentence only has **one negative word: no.**

Now, let's add a second negative word to the same sentence, "I'm not no villain." It might sound like you're saying that you're not a villain, but the second negative word changes the sentence (and its meaning) into the opposite of what you wanted to say. If you're not no villain, then you must be a villain.

no villain = no villain not no villain = yes villain

Pronunciation of Lg7

In English the pronunciation of 'g' generally (but not always) depends on the letter that follows it.

The general rule is this: if the letter after 'g' is 'e', 'i' or 'y', the pronunciation is a 'soft g' as in 'fringe'.

Some examples of words with the soft 'g' are:

-General, giant, gymnastics, large, energy and change.

Any other letter that follows requires a 'hard' pronunciation of 'g' as in 'progress' and some more examples are:

-Golf, pig, great, grasp and gum.


A bit of extra info for you: if a word derives from German, it's usually a hard 'g', and if it is a Latin or French derivative, it's a soft 'g'.




Silly Vasilly's Chuckle Chamber


